ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 116 and 132 of the Social Security Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title, commencement, and application—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Laboratory Diagnostic Services) Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 9, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Social Security (Laboratory Diagnostic Services) Regulations 1981* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) Except as provided in subclause (3) of this regulation, these regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, and shall apply to laboratory diagnostic services provided on or after that date of commencement. In respect of laboratory

diagnostic services provided before that date of commencement, the principal regulations shall continue to apply as if these regulations had not been made.

- (3) In respect of the tests specified by code references C10, C50, and D70 in Part I of the Schedule to the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 6 (1) of these regulations), regulations 4 and 6 of these regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of May 1989 and shall apply in respect of laboratory diagnostic services provided on or after that date. In respect of laboratory diagnostic services (being tests specified by the said code references) provided before that date, the principal regulations shall continue to apply as if these regulations had not been made.
- **2. Application of regulations**—Regulation 4 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Social Security (Laboratory Diagnostic Services) Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 7) is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (a), and substituting the following paragraph:
 - "(a) That they are performed—
 - "(i) By or under the supervision of a recognised pathologist; or
 - "(ii) By a laboratory assistant approved by the Director-General of Health (either generally or in respect of the particular services) under the supervision of a medical practitioner employed or engaged by an area health board:".
- **3. Payment of fees for laboratory services**—(1) Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (2), and substituting the following subclause:
- "(2) Notwithstanding anything in subclause (1) of this regulation, in any case where the medical practitioner at whose request the laboratory diagnostic services are provided has requested that all the tests comprised in any one of the group tests specified by code reference in Part II of the Schedule to these regulations be performed in respect of a particular patient, the fee prescribed in respect of each such group test shall be payable by the Department, whether or not some other fee in respect of any of the individual tests that comprise that group test is prescribed in Part I of the said Schedule."
- (2) Regulation 4 of the Social Security (Laboratory Diagnostic Services) Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 1 is hereby consequentially revoked.
- **4. Amount of goods and services tax included**—The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 8, the following regulation:
- "8A. The fees prescribed in the Schedule to these regulations are inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985."
- **5. Payment to recognised pathologists**—Regulation 9 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (2), and substituting the following subclauses:

"(2) Every claim by a recognised pathologist under these regulations for payment of fees shall be made in the first instance to the Department, and shall be made in a format approved by the Director-General of Health.

"(2A) The maximum number of claims that may be made by a recognised pathologist for any test specified in the Schedule to these regulations performed in respect of any particular patient on any one day shall not exceed the number specified in respect of that test in the said Schedule."

6. New Schedule to principal regulations—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Schedule (as substituted by regulation 2 (1) of the Social Security (Laboratory Diagnostic Services) Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 6), and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) The Social Security (Laboratory Diagnostic Services) Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 6 and the Social Security (Laboratory Diagnostic Services) Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 8 are hereby consequentially

revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations make various amendments to the Social Security (Laboratory Diagnostic Services) Regulations 1981.

Regulation 2 amends the principal regulations to provide that they will apply to laboratory diagnostic services performed under the supervision rather than the direct supervision of a recognised pathologist. In addition the term "bacteriological assistant" is replaced by the term "laboratory assistant".

Regulation 3 amends that part of regulation 8 of the principal regulations relating to group tests. The amendment is consequential to the new format of the new Schedule.

Regulation 4 provides that the prescribed fees are inclusive of goods and services tax.

Regulation 5 makes 2 amendments to regulation 9 of the principal regulations.

The first amendment provides for claims to be made to the Head Office of the Department

of Health instead of to the abolished district offices.

The second amendment inserts a new provision dealing with the maximum number of claims that may be made in respect of any particular test carried out on a patient on any one day. The maximum number in respect of each test is set out in the new Schedule.

Regulation 6 provides for a new Schedule to the principal regulations. The new Schedule is in a different format from the previous Schedule and the prescribed fees now include goods and services tax.

The fees specified under code references C10, C50, and D70 apply in respect of services provided on and after 1 May 1989.
