## Regulations

#### 1 Title

(1) These regulations are the Social Security (Income Exemption: Home-based Care) Amendment Regulations 2006. (2) In these regulations, the Social Security (Income Exemption: Home-based Care) Regulations 2004 are called "the principal regulations".

#### 2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 April 2006.

#### **3** Application

These regulations apply to payments for home-based care received by a caregiver on or after the day these regulations come into force.

#### 4 Declaring certain amounts not to be income

Regulation 5(2)(a) of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expression "\$2.74", and substituting the expression "\$2.83".

#### **Explanatory note**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 2006, amend the Social Security (Income Exemption: Home-based Care) Regulations 2004.

The amendment raises the amount that is declared not to be the income of a caregiver who receives payment for providing homebased care, arranged by an arranger, in accordance with the code of practice set out in the Schedule of the Education (Home-based Care) Order 1992. The raised amount is in accordance with a 3.16% increase in the All Groups Consumers Price Index. Issued under the authority of the Acts and Regulations Publication Act 1989. Date of notification in *Gazette*: 9 March 2006. These regulations are administered in the Ministry of Social Development.
