- 1 Title**
This order is the Social Security (Funeral Grants) Order 2003.
- 2 Commencement**
This order is deemed to come into force on 1 July 2003.

3 Increasing amounts of funeral grants

- (1) Sections 61DB, 61DC, and 61DD of the Social Security Act 1964 are amended by omitting from each section the expression “\$1,236.26”, and substituting in each case the expression “\$1,545.33”.
- (2) The amendments made by subclause (1) apply in respect of persons who die on or after 1 July 2003.

4 Revocation

Clause 3 of the Social Security (Rates of Benefits and Allowances) Order 2003 (SR 2003/44) is revoked.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 July 2003, increases the maximum amounts of funeral grants under sections 61DB, 61DC, and 61DD of the Social Security Act 1964 from \$1,236.26 to \$1,545.33. The increases apply in respect of persons who die on or after 1 July 2003.
