

# THE SECONDARY SCHOOL GRANTS REGULATIONS 1967, AMENDMENT NO. 2

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 10th day of November 1969

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Secondary School Grants Regulations 1967, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Secondary School Grants Regulations 1967\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Grants for general expenses—Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (a) of subclause (1), and substituting the following paragraph:

"(a) A grant applicable in accordance with regulation 6 of these regulations, which grant shall be ascertained in accordance with the following scale:
