ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 26th day of September 1988

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL PURSUANT to section 27 (2) of the State Sector Act 1988, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the State Sector Order 1988.

(2) Except as provided in clause 3 (2) of this order, this order shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Additional Departments of the Public Service—(1) The First Schedule to the State Sector Act 1988 is hereby amended by inserting, after the item relating to the Cabinet Office, the following item:

"Ministry of Commerce."

(2) The said First Schedule is hereby further amended by inserting, after the item relating to the Government Printing Office, the following item:

"Government Superannuation Fund Department."

(3) The said First Schedule is hereby further amended by inserting, after the item relating to the Department of Maori Affairs, the following items:

"National Library Department.

"National Provident Fund Department."

3. Ministry of External Relations and Trade—(1) The First Schedule to the State Sector Act 1988 is hereby further amended by inserting, after the item relating to the Ministry for the Environment, the following item:

"Ministry of External Relations and Trade."

(2) This clause shall come into force on the 1st day of December 1988.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order adds the names of 5 new Departments of the Public Service to the First Schedule to the State Sector Act 1988.

The names of the Ministry of Commerce, the Government Superannuation Fund Department, the National Library Department, and the National Provident Fund Department are added on the 28th day after the date of the notification of this order in the *Gazette*.

The name of the Ministry of External Relations and Trade is added on the 1st day of December 1988.
