Pursuant to section 27 (2) of the State Sector Act 1988, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the State Sector Order 1994.
 - (2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1995.
- 2. Department for Courts—The First Schedule to the State Sector Act 1988 (as substituted by section 28 (1) of the State Sector Amendment Act (No. 2) 1989) is hereby amended by inserting, after the item relating to the Department of Conservation, the following item:

"Department for Courts."

3. Ministry of Fisheries—The First Schedule to the State Sector Act 1988 (as substituted by section 28 (1) of the State Sector Amendment Act (No. 2) 1989) is hereby amended by inserting, after the item relating to the Ministry for the Environment, the following item:

"Ministry of Fisheries."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 July 1995, adds the name of the Department for Courts and the name of the Ministry of Fisheries to the First Schedule to the State Sector Act 1988. That Schedule lists the Departments of the Public Service.
