PURSUANT to section 27 (2) of the State Sector Act 1988, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the State Sector Order (No. 2) 1988.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1989.

2. Ministry of Maori Affairs—The First Schedule to the State Sector Act 1988 is hereby amended by inserting, after the item relating to the Department of Maori Affairs, the following item:

“Ministry of Maori Affairs.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 July 1989, adds the name of the Ministry of Maori Affairs to the First Schedule to the State Sector Act 1988. That Schedule lists the Departments of the Public Service.
