ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 7th day of August 1989

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 27 (2) of the State Sector Act 1988, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the State Sector Order (No. 3) 1989.
- (2) Except as provided in clause 3 (2) of this order, this order shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Serious Fraud Office—The First Schedule to the State Sector Act 1988 is hereby amended by inserting, after the item relating to the Department of Scientific and Industrial Research, the following item:

"Serious Fraud Office."

- **3. Ministry of Research, Science, and Technology**—(1) The First Schedule to the State Sector Act 1988 is hereby further amended by inserting, after the item relating to the Public Trust Office, the following item:
 - "Ministry of Research, Science, and Technology."
 - (2) This clause shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1989.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order adds the names of 2 new Departments of the Public Service to the First Schedule to the State Sector Act 1988.

The name of the Serious Fraud Office is added on the 28th day after the date of the notification of the order in the Gazette.

The name of the Ministry of Research, Science, and Technology is added on 1 October 1989.
