HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to section 61H of the Social Security Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Social Security (Rates of Benefits) Order (No. 2) 1986.
- (2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1986.
- 2. Increasing rates of benefits on and after 1 April 1986—Each provision of the Social Security Act 1964 specified in the first column of the Schedule to this order is hereby amended by omitting every expression set out opposite to it in the second column of that Schedule, wherever that expression occurs, and substituting in each case the expression set out opposite to it in the third column of that Schedule.
- **3. Revocation**—The Social Security (Rates of Benefits) Order 1986* is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but it is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order increases the rates of widows', invalids', miners', domestic purposes, sickness, unemployment, and related emergency benefits on and after 1 April 1986. The rates of the benefits are increased by \$2.66 a week for unmarried persons and \$4.42 a week for married

The rate of child supplement for the first child of a solo parent receiving a social security benefit is increased by \$1.76 to \$72.47 a week.

The rate of orphans' benefits is increased by \$1.31 to \$58.05 a week.

The "hospital" rate of benefit payable to long-term hospital patients, and the rate of the special disability allowance paid as a hospital visiting allowance, are increased by \$1 to \$16 a week.
