ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 61H of the Social Security Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Social Security (Rates of Benefits) Order (No. 4) 1984.
- (2) Clause 2 of, and the First Schedule to, this order shall come into force on the 5th day of December 1984.
- (3) Clause 3 of, and the Second Schedule to, this order shall come into force on the 26th day of November 1984.
- 2. Increasing rates of certain benefits on and after 5 December 1984—Each provision of the Social Security Act 1964 specified in the first column of the First Schedule to this order is hereby amended by omitting every expression set out opposite to it in the second column of that Schedule, wherever that expression occurs, and substituting in each case the expression set out opposite to it in the third column of that Schedule.
- 3. Increasing rates of certain benefits on and after 26 November 1984—Each provision of the Social Security Act 1964 specified in the first column of the Second Schedule to this order is hereby amended by omitting

every expression set out opposite to it in the second column of that Schedule, wherever that expression occurs, and substituting in each case the expression set out opposite to it in the third column of that Schedule.

4. Revocation—The Social Security (Rates of Benefits) Order (No. 3) 1984 is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order increases the rates of widows', invalids', miners', domestic purposes, and related emergency benefits on and after 5 December 1984. It also increases the rates of sickness, unemployment, and related emergency benefits on and after 26 November 1984.

The rates of the benefits are increased by \$3.60 a week for unmarried persons and \$6 a week for married couples.

The rate of child supplement for each dependent child of a married couple and for the second and each subsequent dependent child of a solo parent is increased by \$2 to \$8 a week.

The rate of child supplement for the first or only dependent child of a solo parent is increased by \$2.40 to \$58.98 a week.

The rate of orphans' benefits is increased by \$1.75 to \$48.05 a week.
