**THE SECONDARY SCHOOLS REGULATIONS 1924,
AMENDMENT NO. 16.**

GALWAY, Governor-General.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 28th day of June, 1939.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Education Act, 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Secondary Schools Regulations 1924, Amendment No. 16.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made by Order in Council dated the 5th day of May, 1924* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July, 1939.

4. Clause 17 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the proviso to subclause (1) thereof (as made by Order in Council dated the 22nd day of December, 1931†).

5. Clause 18 of the principal regulations is further amended by—

(1) Revoking subclause (6) thereof (as made by the Secondary Schools Regulations 1924, Amendment No. 14,‡ and substituting the following :—

“(6) (a) Notwithstanding anything in subclause (5) of this clause, any teacher classified in Grade C or a higher grade and occupying a position of Grade D on the staff of a school shall receive annual increments until the maximum salary for a Grade C position is reached.

“(b) Any teacher classified in Grade B or a higher grade and occupying a position of Grade C or lower grade on the staff of a school shall receive annual increments until the maximum salary for a Grade B position is reached. Any such teacher who has, on the 1st day of July, 1939, been receiving the maximum salary for a Grade C position for not less than twelve months shall, from the said 1st day of July, receive salary at the rate shown for the first subdivision of Grade B in Schedule III.”

- (2) Revoking subclause (8) thereof (as added by the Secondary Schools Regulations 1924, Amendment No. 14*) and substituting the following:—

“(8) A teacher classified in grade B or in a higher grade appointed hereafter to a Grade C or Grade D position either as a permanent or as a relieving teacher, and in the latter case, notwithstanding the provisions of the proviso to clause 38 hereof, shall receive salary at a rate shown in Subdivision 1 of Grade B of Schedule III to subclause (1) of this clause, or such other salary within Grade B as is approved by the Director in accordance with the proviso to subclause (4) of this clause.”
