### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 26th day of June 1974

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the State Services Salary Order (No. 10) 1974.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1974.

**2. Higher salaries**—(1) The salaries set out in the Schedule hereto in respect of the positions mentioned in that Schedule (being positions excluded by the Minister, by notice in the *Gazette*, from Parts II, III, and IV of the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969) may be paid in respect of those positions.

(2) The increments that are payable shall in each case be annual increments.
