THE STATE SERVICES SALARY ORDER (NO. 11) 1974

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 26th day of June 1974

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the State Services Salary Order (No. 11) 1974.

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1974.

2. Higher salary—The yearly rate of salary payable to the officer holding on the 1st day of April 1974 the position of Assistant General Manager (Finance and Administration) in the New Zealand Government Railways Department shall, so long as he holds that position, be as follows

- (a) Yearly rate of salary on and after the 1st day of April 1974, \$15,379;
- (b) Yearly rate of salary on and after the 1st day of July 1974, \$16,763.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order prescribes increased rates of salary for the position of Assistant General Manager (Finance and Administration), New Zealand Government Railways Department. The rate is personal to the present holder of that position.
