THE STATE SERVICES SALARY ORDER 1972

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 14th day of February 1972

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and, in relation to the positions in the Ministry of Transport and the Department of Agriculture specified in the First and Second Schedules to this order, on the recommendation to the Prime Minister made by the Remuneration Authority pursuant to section 25 of the Stabilisation of Remuneration Act 1971, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the State Services Salary Order 1972.

(2) Except as provided in subclause (3) of this clause and in clause 3 of this order, this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 15th day of April 1970.

(3) Subclause (2) of clause 2 of this order and the Second Schedule to this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1971.

2. Higher salaries—(1) Commencing with the dates respectively shown in the headings of the columns in the First Schedule to this order headed “Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 15 April 1970”, “Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 15 July 1970”, and “Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 15 January 1971”, the salaries set out in that Schedule in respect of the positions mentioned therein (being salaries exceeding the amount prescribed by Order in Council under section 18 (1) of the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969) may be paid in respect of those positions.

(2) Commencing with the date shown in the column of the Second Schedule to this order headed “Effective Date”, the salary set out in that

Schedule in respect of the position mentioned in that Schedule (being a salary exceeding the amount prescribed by Order in Council under the said section 18 (1)) may be paid in respect of that position.

(3) The increments that are payable shall in each case be annual increments.

3. Amendments—The Second Schedule to the State Services Salary Order (No. 7) 1971* is hereby amended as from its commencement by omitting so much thereof as relates to positions in the Ministry of Transport and in the Defence Forces.
