THE STATE SERVICES SALARY ORDER 1974

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 18th day of February 1974

Present:

THE HON. H. WATT PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the State Services Salary Order 1974.

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1973.

2. Higher salaries—(1) Salaries, at the rates and in respect of the periods set out in the First Schedule to this order, may be paid to the persons who occupy the positions mentioned in that Schedule (being positions excluded by the Minister, by notice in the *Gazette*, from Parts II, III, and IV of the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969).

(2) Salaries, at the rates and in respect of the periods set out in the Second Schedule to this order, (being salaries exceeding the amount prescribed by Order in Council under section 18 (1) of the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969) may be paid to the persons who occupy the positions mentioned in that Schedule.

(3) The increments that are payable shall in each case be annual increments.

3. Amendment—The First Schedule to the State Services Salary Order (No. 9) 1973* is hereby amended by revoking so much thereof as relates to the positions of Deputy General Manager, State Insurance, Deputy Secretary, Transport, and the Deputy Controller and Auditor General.
