ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 9th day of March 1970

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the State Services Salary Order (No. 2) 1970.

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 15th day of June 1969.

2. Higher Salaries—(1) The salaries set out in the First Schedule hereto in respect of the positions mentioned in that Schedule (being positions excluded by the Minister, by notice in the *Gazette*, from Parts II, III, and IV of the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969) may be paid in respect of those positions.

(2) The salaries set out in the Second Schedule hereto in respect of the positions mentioned in that Schedule (being salaries exceeding the amount prescribed by Order in Council under subsection (1) of section 18 of the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969) may be paid in respect of those positions.

(3) The increments that are payable shall in each case be annual increments.

3. Revocation—The State Services Salary Order (No. 2) 1969* is hereby revoked.
