THE STATE SERVICES SALARY ORDER (NO. 2) 1974

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 18th day of February 1974

Present:

PURSUANT to the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the State Services Salary Order (No. 2) 1974.

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 11th day of February 1974.

2. Maximum salary that an employing authority may prescribe—For the purposes of subsection (1) of section 18 of the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969, the maximum salary that any employing authority may prescribe shall be \$13,706 a year.

3. Maximum salary that the State Services Tribunal may prescribe—For the purposes of subsection (4) of section 32 of the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969, the maximum salary that the State Services Tribunal may by order prescribe shall be \$13,706 a year.

4. Maximum salary that a Single Service Tribunal may prescribe—For the purposes of subsection (4) of section 44 of the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969, the maximum salary that a Single Service Tribunal may by order prescribe shall be \$13,706 a year.

5. Revocation—The State Services Salary Order (No. 7) 1973* is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order specifies the maximum salary that may be prescribed under the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969 by an employing authority or the State Services Tribunal or a Single Service Tribunal. It increases the maximum by 2.7 percent consequent on the wage adjustment order made under regulation 14 (4) of the Economic Stabilisation Regulations 1973. The wage adjustment order came into force on 11 February 1974 and this order is retrospective to that date.
