



**THE STATE SERVICES SALARY ORDER (NO. 2) 1987**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At Wellington this 14th day of December 1987

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the State Services Conditions of Employment Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the State Services Salary Order (No. 2) 1987.

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 10th day of November 1987.

**2. Maximum salary that an employing authority may prescribe**—For the purposes of section 20(1) of the State Services Conditions of Employment Act 1977, the maximum salary that any employing authority may by determination prescribe shall be \$63,800.

**3. Maximum salary that the Arbitration Commission may prescribe**—For the purposes of section 79A(3) of the State Services Conditions of Employment Act 1977, the maximum salary that the Arbitration Commission may by order prescribe shall be \$63,800.

**4. Revocation**—The State Services Salary Order 1987\* is hereby revoked.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order, which is deemed to have come into force on 10 November 1987, increases to \$63,800 the maximum salary that may be prescribed under the State Services Conditions of Employment Act 1977 by an employing authority or the Arbitration Commission.
