ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 26th day of April 1973

PURSUANT to the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

i. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the State Services Salary Order (No. 4) 1973.

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1973.

2. Deputy Secretary of Foreign Affairs—(1) The salary set out in the Schedule to this order in respect of the position of Deputy Secretary of Foreign Affairs (being a position excluded by the Minister, by notice in the *Gazette*, from Parts II, III, and IV of the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969) may be paid in respect of that position.

(2) The increment that is payable shall be an annual increment.
