ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 4th day of March 1974

Present:

THE HON. H. WATT PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

O R D E R

1. Title—This order may be cited as the State Services Salary Order (No. 4) 1974.

2. Salary of Chief Pilot, Calibration Flight, Ministry of Transport—(1) Commencing with the dates respectively shown in the column in the Schedule hereto headed "Effective Date" the salary set out in that Schedule in respect of the position of Chief Pilot, Calibration Flight, Ministry of Transport (being a salary exceeding the amount prescribed by Order in Council under section 18 (1) of the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969) may be paid in respect of that position.

(2) The increments that are payable shall in each case be annual increments.
