Pursuant to the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation to the Prime Minister made by the Remuneration Authority pursuant to regulation 26 of the Stabilisation of Remuneration Regulations 1972*, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the State Services Salary Order (No. 6) 1972.
- (2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of September 1972.
- 2. Higher salaries—(1) The salary set out in the Schedule to this order in respect of the position mentioned therein (being a position excluded by the Minister, by notice in the *Gazette*, from Parts II, III, and IV of the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969) may be paid in respect of that position.
 - (2) The increment that is payable shall be an annual increment.
- 3. Amendment—The State Services Salary Order (No. 3) 1972† is hereby amended by revoking so much of the First Schedule as relates to the position of Secretary for Marine.
