Pursuant to the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation to the Prime Minister made by the Remuneration Authority pursuant to regulation 26 of the Stabilisation of Remuneration Regulations 1972*, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title—This order may be cited as the State Services Salary Order (No. 9) 1972.
- 2. Higher salaries—(1) Commencing with the dates respectively shown in the column in the Schedule hereto headed "Effective Date" the salaries set out in that Schedule in respect of the positions mentioned in that Schedule (being salaries exceeding the amount prescribed by Order in Council under section 18 (1) of the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969) may be paid in respect of those positions.
- (2) The increments that are payable shall in each case be annual increments.
