REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Pharmaceutical Supplies) Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 1.
- 2. Clause 8 of the Social Security (Pharmaceutical Supplies) Regulations 1941 is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (2) the words "and shall be countersigned by the Medical Officer of Health of the District", and by revoking subclause (3).
