

# THE SECONDARY SCHOOL TECHNICAL BURSARIES REGULATIONS 1977, AMENDMENT NO. 3

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 3rd day of June 1980 Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Secondary School Technical Bursaries Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Secondary School Technical Bursaries Regulations 1977\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Applications for bursaries—Regulation 13 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—
  - (a) By omitting the words "than the 30th day of November of the year immediately preceding", and substituting the words "than the 31st day of March of"; and
  - (b) By omitting the words "after the 30th day of November", and substituting the words "after the 31st day of March".

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations extend the date by which an application for the award of a secondary school technical bursary in respect of any year must be made from 30 November in the previous year to 31 March in the year concerned.
