



**THE SALES TAX DETERMINATION NOTICE 1980,
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

PURSUANT to item 2 of Part G of the First Schedule to the Sales Tax Act 1974, the Minister of Customs hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Sales Tax Determination Notice 1980, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Sales Tax Determination Notice 1980* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Part of the Schedule revoked—Item 15 of the Schedule of the principal notice is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The amendment set out in this notice removes spirit levels, set squares, and similar tradesmen's tools from the determination. Such goods become exempt from sales tax pursuant to item 141 of the Sales Tax Exemption Order 1979.
