ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 27th day of October, 1948

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 12 of the Sales Tax Act, 1932–33, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Sales Tax Exemption Order 1948, No. 2.

2. This Order shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.

3. The goods of the classes and kinds specified in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from sales tax.

SCHEDULE

BOLTS, nuts, rivets, washers, screws, engineers' studs, taper pins, and split pins. Iron and steel, unworked, viz :---

Angle, bar, bolt, channel, tee, and rod. Girders, including expanded girders. Sheet, plate and hoop.
