THE SALES TAX EXEMPTION ORDER 1952

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 10th day of December 1952

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 12 of the Sales Tax Act 1932-33, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Sales Tax Exemption Order 1952.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The goods of the classes and kinds specified in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from sales tax.

SCHEDULE

FIRE fighting equipment—viz., fire engines; chemical fire-engines; chemical fire-extinguishers, including chemicals for charging the same; fire-hose, and couplings therefor, portable fire-escapes, fire-ladders, and fire-reels; and such other articles peculiar to use by fire-brigades or in fire extinguishing as may be approved by the Minister of Customs.
