PURSUANT to section 12 of the Sales Tax Act 1932–33, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. (1) This order may be cited as the Sales Tax Exemption Order 1954.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. The goods of the classes and kinds specified in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from sales tax.

SCHEDULE

ANTISEPTICS, being liquid compounds which comply with the provisions of the Food and Drug Regulations 1946 relating to the labelling and sale of antiseptics.
