**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 11th day of October 1967

Present:

**HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to section 12 of the Sales Tax Act 1932-33, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

---

**ORDER**

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Sales Tax Exemption Order 1967, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Sales Tax Exemption Order 1967\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. (1) Goods of the classes or kinds specified in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from sales tax.

(2) The Second Schedule to the principal order is hereby consequentially amended by inserting, in their appropriate numerical order, the items set out in the Schedule hereto.

## SCHEDULE

## EXEMPTIONS FROM SALES TAX

Item No.	Goods
260A	Road-rail and similar containers specially designed to be equally suitable for transport by rail, road, and ship.
329A	Vehicles, tractors, and fittings therefor, viz: Wagons, trolleys, or wheeled pallets, not being road trailers, specially designed for the handling of bulk cargo containers, as may be approved by the Minister and under such security as the Collector may require that they will be exported.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order exempts from sales tax certain bulk containers specially designed for the transportation of goods.

The order also makes provision for the Minister to approve the exemption of transporters (not being road trailers) specially designed for the handling of bulk cargo containers, under security that they will be exported.
