PURSUANT to section 12 of the Sales Tax Act 1932-33, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Sales Tax Exemption Order 1967, Amendment No. 7, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Sales Tax Exemption Order 1967* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Revocation of exemption—The Second Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by revoking item 119.
