ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 15 of the Sales Tax Act 1974, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Sales Tax Exemption Order 1974, Amendment No. 9, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Sales Tax Exemption Order 1974\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 28th day of November 1977.

**2. Goods exempted from sales tax**—(1) Goods of the class or kind specified in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from sales tax.

(2) The First Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by revoking item 329, and substituting the item 329 set out in the Schedule hereto.
