PURSUANT to section 15 of the Sales Tax Act 1974, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Sales Tax Exemption Order 1979, Amendment No. 14, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Sales Tax Exemption Order 1979* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the 13th day of December 1984.

2. Sales tax exemptions—(1) Goods of the classes and kinds specified in the School less tax exemptions—(1) doors of the classes and kinds specified

in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from sales tax.

(2) The First Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by revoking item 300, and substituting the new item 300 specified in the Schedule hereto.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 13 December 1984, provides for the exemption from sales tax on omnibuses designed to carry 9 or more seated passengers. The present exemption applies to omnibuses designed to carry 10 or more seated passengers.
