Pursuant to section 15 of the Sales Tax Act 1974, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Sales Tax Exemption Order 1979, Amendment No. 3 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Sales Tax Exemption Order 1979* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).
- (2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 17th day of May 1979.
- 2. Goods exempted from sales tax—(1) Goods of the class or kind specified in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from sales tax.
- (2) The First Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by inserting, after item 261, the new item 261A set out in the Schedule hereto.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The effect of this order is to exempt solar water heating systems from sales tax as from 17 May 1979.
