**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 3rd day of August 1981

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL BY HIS DEPUTY IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 15 of the Sales Tax Act 1974, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Sales Tax Exemption Order 1979, Amendment No. 9, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Sales Tax Exemption Order 1979\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the 14th day after its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Sales tax exemptions**—(1) Clause 3 (2) of the principal order is hereby amended by inserting after the expression “204”, the expression “245, 246,”.

(2) Goods of the class or kind specified in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from sales tax.

(3) The First Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by revoking item 246, and substituting the new item 246 specified in the Schedule hereto.
