## ORDER IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Sales Tax Act 1974, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Sales Tax Regulations 1974, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Sales Tax Regulations 1974\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of May 1979.
- 2. Application for licence—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking subclause (2) of regulation 8.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Sales Tax Regulations 1974 and provide that, on and after 1 May 1979, the \$2 licence fee for wholesalers and manufacturing retailers is abolished.
