### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 17th day of April 1979.

PURSUANT to the Sales Tax Act 1974, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Sales Tax Regulations 1974, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Sales Tax Regulations 1974\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of May 1979.

**2. Application for licence**—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking subclause (2) of regulation 8.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations amend the Sales Tax Regulations 1974 and provide that, on and after 1 May 1979, the \$2 licence fee for wholesalers and manufacturing retailers is abolished.
