PURSUANT to section 12A of the Sales Tax Act 1974 (as inserted by section 18 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act (No. 2) 1976), His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Sales Tax Rates Modification Order 1983.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of September 1983.

2. Part of the First Schedule suspended—Item 8 of Part C and Items 7 and 8 of Part E of the First Schedule to the Sales Tax Act 1974 (as substituted by section 15 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1982) are hereby suspended.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The effect of this order is to reduce the rate of tax on—

- (a) Marine outboard engines having a maximum rated output exceeding 7.5 kilowatts from 40 percent to 20 percent;
- (b) Marine outboard engines having a maximum rated output not exceeding 7.5 kilowatts from 30 percent to 20 percent;
- (c) Marine inboard engines from 30 percent to 20 percent;
- (d) Parts and accessories for marine engines from 30 percent to 20 percent.
