**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to section 12A of the Sales Tax Act 1974 (as inserted by section 18 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act (No. 2) 1976), His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Sales Tax Rates Modification Order (No. 3) 1979.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Part of the First Schedule suspended**—Item 8 of Part C of the First Schedule to the Sales Tax Act 1974 (as substituted by section 7 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1977) is hereby suspended.

**3. Sales tax imposed**—The sales tax set out in the Schedule to this order is hereby imposed.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The effect of this order is to reduce the rate of tax on statuettes, vases, and ornaments from 40 percent to 10 percent.
