THE SANITARY WORKS REGULATIONS, 1936.

Enacting authority: His Excellency the Governor-General in Council. Act pursuant to which the regulations were made: The Health Act, 1920.

Date on which the regulations were made: 9th day of December, 1936. Date of notification in *Gazette*: 8th day of January, 1937.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Sanitary Works Regulations, 1936.
- 2. The works referred to in the Schedule hereto are declared to be sanitary works to the intent that the term "sanitary works" shall for the purposes of section 22 of the Health Act, 1920, be deemed to include the works referred to in the said Schedule.

SCHEDULE.

(1) Swimming-baths.

(2) Dressing-sheds at or adjacent to sea-beaches, river-banks, and other natural bathing-places, artificial swimming-baths, and lands and premises used or intended for use as recreation-grounds or for athletic exercises.
