# GALWAY, Governor-General. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 6th day of October, 1938.

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Health Act, 1920, His Excellency the Governor-General in Council doth hereby make the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS.

- ${\bf 1.}$  These regulations may be cited as the Sanitary Works Regulations 1938.
- 2. The works referred to in the Schedule hereto are declared to be sanitary works to the intent that the term "sanitary works" shall for the purposes of section 22 of the Health Act, 1920, be deemed to include the works referred to in the said schedule.
