ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 12th day of February, 1941.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Health Act, 1920, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Sanitary Works Regulations 1941.

2. The works referred to in the Schedule hereto are declared to be sanitary works to the intent that the term "sanitary works" shall for the purposes of section 22 of the Health Act, 1920, be deemed to include the works referred to in the said Schedule.
