- 2. Commencement of clause 5 of order—Clause 5 of the Social Welfare (Reciprocity with Australia) Amendment Order 1995* shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1996.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order brings into force, from 1 January 1996, clause 5 of the Social Welfare (Reciprocity with Australia) Amendment Order 1995, which modifies the Social Welfare (Transitional Provisions) Act 1990 and Social Security Act 1964 so as to give effect to the Second Protocol to the Agreement between the Governments of New Zealand and Australia on Social Security. The Second Protocol is set out in the Second Schedule to that order.
