- 1. Title—This order may be cited as the Transport Amendment Act Commencement Order 1969.
- 2. Commencement of provisions of Transport Amendment Act 1968—Sections 13, 14, and 29 of the Transport Amendment Act 1968 shall come into force on the 1st day of May 1969.
