Pursuant to section 2 (2) of the Transport Amendment Act 1980, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

# ORDER

- 1. Title—This order may be cited as the Transport Amendment Act Commencement Order 1981.
- 2. Commencement of specified provisions of Act—The following provisions of the Transport Amendment Act 1980 shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1981:
  - (a) Subsections (2) to (6) of section 2:
  - (b) Sections 7 and 8:
  - (c) The Schedule.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order brings into force, on 1 April 1981, those provisions of the Transport Amendment Act 1980 relating to:

(a) Owner liability for parking offences; and
(b) Infringement offences (including parking infringement offences) and the procedures that may apply to such offences.
