ORDER

1. **Title**—This order may be cited as the Transport Amendment Act Commencement Order 1981.

2. **Commencement of specified provisions of Act**—The following provisions of the Transport Amendment Act 1980 shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1981:

- (a) Subsections (2) to (6) of section 2:
- (b) Sections 7 and 8:
- (c) The Schedule.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order brings into force, on 1 April 1981, those provisions of the Transport Amendment Act 1980 relating to:

- (a) Owner liability for parking offences; and
- (b) Infringement offences (including parking infringement offences) and the procedures that may apply to such offences.
