PURSUANT to the Termites Act 1940, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. This order may be cited as the Termites Act Application Order 1956.
- 2. The local authorities set out in the Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be local authorities to which the provisions of the Termites Act 1940 apply.
- 3. This Order in Council shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
