PURSUANT to the Termites Act 1940, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. (1) This order may be cited as the Termites Act Application Order 1966.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. The Franklin County Council is hereby declared to be a local authority to which the provisions of the Termites Act 1940 apply.
