PURSUANT to section 128 (3) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Town and Country Planning (Planning Tribunal) Order 1978.

2. Naming Divisions of Tribunal—The 3 Divisions of the Planning Tribunal shall be known as the Number One Division, the Number Two Division, and the Number Three Division, respectively.
