



**THE TELEX AND DATEX REGULATIONS 1981,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 26th day of January 1982

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Post Office Act 1959, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Telex and Datex Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Telex and Datex Regulations 1981* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) Subject to subclause (3) of this regulation, these regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of February 1982.

(3) Regulations 2, 4, 5, and 7 of these regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1982.

2. Joint use of telex installation—Regulation 11 (3) of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

(a) By omitting the expression “\$6.25”, and substituting the expression “\$10”;

(b) By omitting the expression “\$5”, and substituting the expression “\$8”.

3. Service connection fee—(1) Regulation 14 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting from paragraph (a) the expression “\$133”, and substituting the expression “\$175”;
- (b) By omitting from paragraph (b) the expression “\$133”, and substituting the expression “\$175”;
- (c) By omitting from paragraph (c) the expression “\$65”, and substituting the expression “\$115”.

(2) Regulation 14 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by adding the following paragraph:

- “(d) If the telex installation or datex installation, internal wiring, and outside circuit are in position from a former connection, and the installation is taken over without alteration except to the telex number and answer-back code, the charge shall be reduced to \$33.”

4. Rental—Regulation 15 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (a), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(a) Telex Service:

“(i) For non-tape installation	112.50
“(ii) For non-tape installation and computer interface unit	127.50
“(iii) For installation with tape facilities	150.00
“(iv) For installation with tape facilities and computer interface unit	165.00
“(v) For non-tape installation with electronic memory	170.00
“(vi) For installation with tape facilities and electronic memory	200.00
“(vii) For non-tape installation with electronic memory and VDU	260.00
“(viii) Supplementary memory for non-tape installation with electronic memory	7.50

“Provided that where, in special circumstances approved by the Director-General, a telex installation does not include a teleprinter, the charges for the installation shall be \$78.00 per month.”

5. Outer area charges—Regulation 16 (2) of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting from paragraph (a) the words “Forty-three cents”, and substituting the words “Sixty cents”;
- (b) By omitting from paragraph (b) the words “Twenty-one cents”, and substituting the words “Thirty cents”.

6. Discontinuance of service of defaulting subscribers—Regulation 22 (4) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression “\$20”, and substituting the expression “\$25”.

7. Additional directory listings—Regulation 25 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting from paragraph (a) the expression “\$1”, and substituting the expression “\$1.50”;
- (b) By omitting from paragraph (b) the expression “63 cents”, and substituting the expression “\$1”.

8. Public telex booths—Regulation 38 (3) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression “25 cents”, and substituting the expression “30 cents”.

9. Telex messages for delivery by Post Office (Teltex)—Regulation 39 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting from subclause (2) (b) the expression “\$1.60”, and substituting the expression “\$2.70”;
- (b) By omitting from subclause (3) (a) the expression “25c”, and substituting the expression “30c”;
- (c) By omitting from subclause (3) (b) the expression “60c”, and substituting the expression “\$1”.

10. Messages lodged by telephone for telex delivery by Post Office (Phonatelex)—Regulation 40 (4) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression “25 cents”, and substituting the expression “30 cents”.

11. Removals—Regulation 43 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting from paragraph (a) the expression “133”, and substituting the expression “175”;
- (b) By omitting from paragraph (a) the expression “27”, and substituting the expression “33”;
- (c) By omitting from paragraph (b) the expression “80”, and substituting the expression “105”.

12. Change of answer-back code—Regulation 45 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression “\$27”, and substituting the expression “\$33”.

13. Connection of telex/computer interface—Regulation 46 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression “\$27”, and substituting the expression “\$33”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase certain charges for the telex and datex services with effect from 1 February 1982, and certain other telex and datex charges with effect from 1 April 1982.
