# THE TERTIARY ASSISTANCE GRANTS REGULATIONS 1982, AMENDMENT NO. 4

## **ORDER IN COUNCIL**

### At Wellington this 28th day of July 1986

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Tertiary Assistance Grants Regulations 1982, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together and deemed part of the Tertiary Assistance Grants Regulations 1982\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1986.

2. Study grants established—Regulation 22 (2) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression "\$37" (as substituted by regulation 3 of the Tertiary Assistance Grants Regulations 1982, Amendment No. 3), and substituting the expression "\$38.85".

**3. Accommodation grant established**—Regulation 35 (2) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression "\$33" (as substituted by regulation 5 of the Tertiary Assistance Grants Regulations 1982, Amendment No. 3), and substituting the expression "\$34.65".

**5. Award of hardship grant**—Regulation 44 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression "\$54" (as substituted by regulation 6 (b) of the Tertiary Assistance Grants Regulations 1984, Amendment No. 3), in both places where it occurs, and substituting, in each case, the expression "\$56.70".

**6. Award of special grant**—Regulation 45 (2) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression "\$54" (as substituted by regulation 7 (2) of the Tertiary Assistance Grants Regulations 1982, Amendment No. 3), and substituting the expression "\$56.70".

**7. Consequential revocations**—Regulations 3, 5, 6 (b), and 7 (2) of the Tertiary Assistance Grants Regulations 1982, Amendment No. 3 are hereby consequentially revoked.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect. These regulations, which come into force on 1 October 1986, increase fixed grants, and the maximum level of the hardship grant and the special grant, by 5 percent.
